- Boarding is managed in compliance with the National Minimum Boarding Standards. Blake Feig is the Designated Safeguarding Lead at Cats Cambridge; Tom Marty is the Designated Safeguarding Lead at CSVPA
- Boarders under the age of 18 live in fully supervised accommodation.
- Access to college accommodation is strictly controlled and monitored, guests are signed in.
- Some college accommodation has added security via CCTV.
- Full time Welfare staff are always available. In addition, Students have access to counselling and medical services.
- The College Health Centre is open from 08:00 – 17:00 Monday to Friday.

- The Catering Manager can support any special dietary requirements.
- The Activities Manager arranges weekday, weekend, and half-term holiday activities.
